How to reach the Pontifical Academy of Social Sciences

In order to reach it, guests must enter Vatican City through one of the Vatican Gates, preferably the Perugino Gate. Please bring a valid ID to show the Vatican Gendarmes at the security checkpoint just inside the Perugino Gate. The Vatican Gendarmes will check that your name is on our guestlist and will explain how to reach the Academy.

Please note: The Casina Pio IV is 5 minutes (or less) by car, from any of the Vatican Gates, or twenty minutes on foot. We kindly ask you to be at the Casina Pio IV by 8:45am on both days of the workshop.


