# **CONCEPT NOTE**

The theme of Jubilee 2025 is HOPE.<sup>1</sup> This will be the theme of our meeting.

One of the key directions for hope is that the UN member states have agreed on a Pact for the Future, which we will discuss.<sup>2</sup> Another important development is the positive statement by the BRICS countries at their recent summit in Kazan, Russia.<sup>3</sup>

Past Jubilee years, and notably Jubilee 2000, have made crucial contributions to global economic justice.

In 2000, Pope John Paul's call for justice on developing country debt helped to spur the Highly Indebted Poor Country (HIPC) Initiative.

Next year's Jubilee will coincide with the UN Financing for Development Summit in Madrid, June 30-July 3, 2025.

We all know about the tribulations facing the world. Our meeting will be about hope to face – and solve – these great challenges: war and peace, environmental sustainability, social justice, the end of poverty.

# April 10-11, 2025. The Fourth UN Finance for Development Summit

The Fraternal Economy workshop will bring together global leaders of the UN system and developing and developed country governments, to discuss the ethical imperatives of the forthcoming UN Finance for Development Summit (June 30 – July 3, 2025). As with the Fraternal Economy meeting on the Summit of the Future, the Finance for Development Summit will permit a highly productive interaction between the Church, finance leaders, philosophers, and economists.

# July 3-4, 2025. Inter-Religious Visions for Multilateralism.

Fratelli Tutti offers a crucial moral lesson for the world: we must encounter "the other" if we are to find peace and wellbeing for ourselves as well. This is the essence of a multilateral system that works. Yet instead of encounter, we have rising levels of hate, warmongering, and outright conflict. This workshop will put the challenge of peaceful multilateralism front and center, drawing from the Church's essential teachings.

# October 2-3, 2025. Presentation of draft Chapters of *Fraternal Economy and the World Crisis*.

The final session of Fraternal Economy will prepare the way for an outcome volume, as a companion to *Ethics in Action* (2022, forward by Pope Francis and Patriarch Bartholomew). The Table of Contents of the new volume will be discussed and agreed in the November 2024 meeting. In addition to the project volume, SDSN will produce a MOOC based on the Fraternal Economy program.
